APPLICATION

Dani Seal PU-1000 should be loaded into a 600ml bulk caulking gun. The product should be gunned into the prepared joint. After application is complete tooling of the surface of the sealant can best be achieved using a gloved finger and soap and water.

♦ CHEMICAL RESISTANCE:

♦ Surface Preparation

It is essential that the joint arises are clean and free from any deleterious matter which could prevent adequate bond to the substrate.

EQUIPMENT CLEANING:

Dani Seal PU-1000 should be removed immediately from tools etc, using Dani Cleaning Fluid. Cured material can only be removed by mechanical means.

Dani Seal PU-1000 is supplied in 600 ml sachets.
